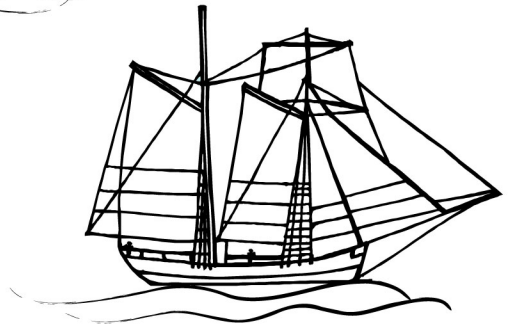
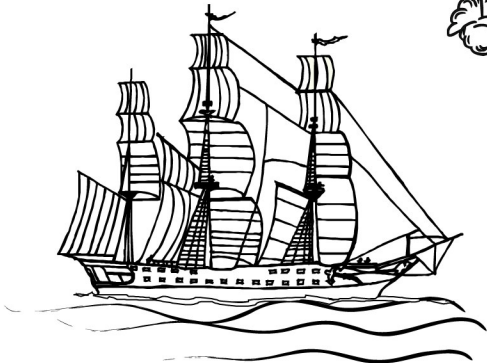
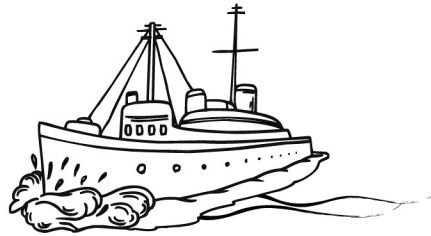
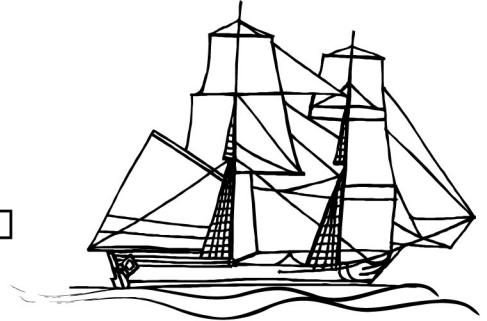




President Grover Cleveland and members of his cabinet, the governor of New York and his staff, along with the French ambassador and a French Committee all attended the dedication of the statue.
